## REGISTRATION RULES

*Please read the Clubs Competitions rules for more details*

- a. In order to participate to a WS.E ILH CLUBS Competition, **national Governing Bodies must be affiliated to WS.E.**
- b. Articles 6 and 7 of EURO CLUBS COMPETITIONS regulations govern players Eligibility for European Clubs Event. Criteria to respect in order to qualify players are:
  - ◆ **Provide a squad list of 22 players** at the registration process.
    - i. For a team in a country where the national championship or cup has started at the end of the registration process
      1. Those players have **to be engaged in national championship or cup** and must have a 30% ratio of game played, national Governing Body is in charge of approving this point
        - a. To calculate this ratio must be use the total of all the matches played in all competitions (championship, cup) by the club, from the start of the season to the last Monday prior to event. The player must have been aligned in at least 30% of the games
    - ii. For the nations, where the national competitions (Cup, Championship) have started before the Official Squad List deadline, the list is final

- iii. For a team in a country where the national championship / cup has not started at the end of the registration process
1. The squad list of max. 22 players is based on **the previous season**
  2. From the list of the previous season, the club must remove all the player engaged and in possession of the European Certificate in another club at the deadline for registering to the event
  3. **Four (4) names of the squad list can be changed**
    - a. At the beginning of the national competition's season (corresponding to the first championship or cup's game), if this date is before the European League,
    - b. Or one month before the start of the European League, if the national competition season starts after the European event
  4. Those players have **to be engaged in national championship or cup in the previous year**, national federation/association is in charge of approving this point
- ✦ All added players must follow the Players Statutes and registration regulation and be in possession of a European Transfer Certificate in the club (see rules)
  - ✦ At the first technical meeting, **each club provides the official delegation list of 16 players** taken from the squad list of 22 players delivered at the registration process
  - ✦ **Art 7.10: The official delegation must respect a minimum amount of players with the same nationality than the team's club, or assimilated players** (in accordance with art. 5). The minimum number of players, to have the same nationality than its club, is **established in the following table:**

- ✦ **Art 7.10: The valid passports or national identity cards** of each of the sixteen (16) players of the Official Delegation **must be presented to the WS.E ILH delegates** at the technical meeting for verification.

## European Transfers Certificate

(see rules and contact your national association)

**5.8 All federations who want to engage teams into a CLUBS COMPETITION event, all teams and players participating to a CLUB COMPETITION must follow the WSE INLINE HOCKEY Players Statutes and Transfers Regulations.**

**5.9 Pursuant article 4 and 5 of the Players Statutes and Transfers Regulations**

- a) A player must be registered with an association to play with a club
- b) Only registered players may participate in the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey
- c) The registered player is required to comply with World Skate, WSE / WSE InLine Hockey and its local association's rules
- d) A player may only be registered with one club in the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey at a time.
- e) However, he may be registered with a Roller Sports club at the same time for the exclusive practice of other Roller disciplines than Roller In Line Hockey. It is not necessary for Roller In Line Hockey and Roller clubs to belong to the same association.
- f) The European Transfer Certificate (ETC) is the only document that allows the registration of a new player in the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey in Europe or the transfer of a player between two associations of the federated network.
- g) A player from an association of the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey in Europe may only be registered in a new association of the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey in Europe, after having received a European Transfer Certificate from the association left.
- h) A player from an association that is not part of the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey or an association that is part of the federated network of Roller In Line Hockey in another continent, during his first registration in an association of Federated network of Roller In Line Hockey in Europe, can only be registered in this association after having received a European Certificate of Transfer, delivered by W.S.E ILH.
- i) The ETC is to be delivered without time limitation. Any contrary provision would be null and void.

**5.10 Pursuant article 9 of the Players Statutes and Transfers Regulations**

- A player who has not been registered with an association and has participated on behalf of a club in an official match will be considered to have played illegally. Notwithstanding any measure required to rectify the sporting consequences of such participation, penalties may also be imposed on the player and / or club. The right to impose such sanctions lies, in principle, with the association or organizer of the competition concerned.
- A player that, after registering in an association of the federated network in Europe, takes a participation in any Roller In Line Hockey competition in any official event of an association not in the federated network, the ETC is considered as non-valid and obsolete on the first day of participation of the player to this event. In order to take part again in an event in Europe, this player is considered as non-registered and must renew its ETC before playing again in the federated network in Europe, otherwise art. 9.1 will apply to him.
